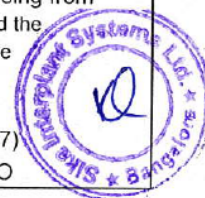

The Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results includes the financial results of 4 subsidiaries which have not been reviewed by their auditors and whose financial results reflect total assets of Rs.159.85 Lakhs and net assets of Rs. 100.80 Lakhs as at June 30, 2026, total revenue of Rs. 1.30 Lakhs, total net profit/(loss) after tax of Rs. (7.35) Lakhs for the period ended June 30, 2026 respectively. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, the financial information of the aforesaid subsidiaries is not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
